Thematic learning, small group and corner teaching are adopted to bolster children's problem-solving skill and self-confidence. Align with moral and civic education, children explore and learn through diverse theme-based educational activities.

Through continuous observation, we observe, record and analyze to understand the development and progress on all aspects of children and suggest for improvements. We also encourage children to participate in self-assessment. "Children learning portfolios" are distributed to parents regularly to give a concrete and objective understanding of their child's development, parents can give appropriate support and assistance where necessary.
