Activities involving self-exploration and group discussion are also implemented to enhance interaction and expand student potential.</p>

<p>To adopt multiple measurement modes, such as measurement checklists, performance assessment and constant observation to record children's performance so as to ensure their learning development is progressing in an active and positive manner.</p>
