Curriculum Details

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

Through holistic innovative education, it provides more opportunities for teacher to interact with students, enhance collaborative learning among peers and build a culture of appreciation. Children's oral expression could also be strengthened in autonomous learning, letting children learn languages with interest from the sharing of life experience. To give children more opportunities to observe, think and improve their problem-solving skills, our school will make good use of the school environment by arranging games in the class corner. Children can use different materials for free exploration as to exert their creativity. It also cultivates children's positive learning attitude and self-confidence.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

Our kindergarten assesses students' learning and development through continuous observation, and regularly report to parent on their children's learning which can strengthen home-school cooperation, and make learning fun and enjoyable for students.
