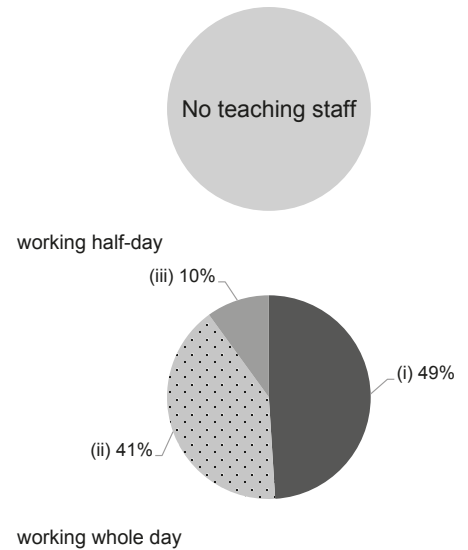

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>We adopt the "activity approach" to develop children's confidence and ability to innovate through activities, such as: games, first-hand experiences, exploration, discussion, observation, visits and reports, thus inspiring / awakening the children's potentials and motivation for active learning.</p>	
Assessment of children's learning experiences	
<p>Teachers make assessments based on their continuous observation of the children, on the recordings and analyses in different learning environments, and using these to formulate appropriate learning goals and plans for children.</p>

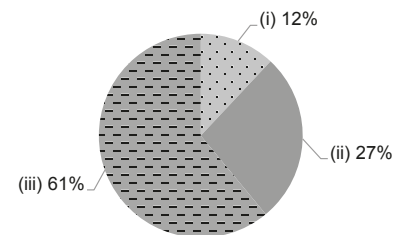
