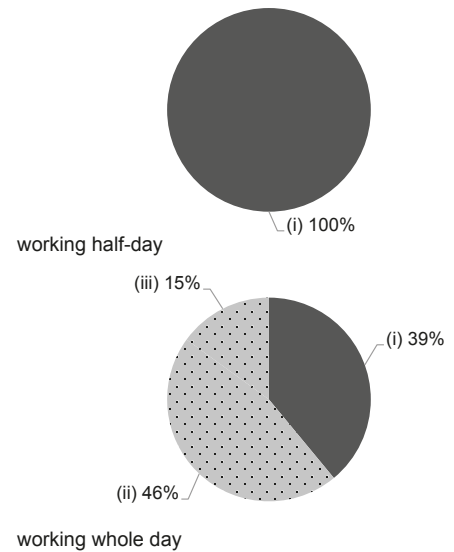

Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
'Topic studies' is the main mode of learning. Opportunities for exploration are provided according to children's interests and experiences to increase their motives of learning. Professional teachers make use of the environment creatively to provide the learning corner as a way to encourage children to learn through games and action besides gaining knowledge and exploration skills.

A profile on child development is kept by stages of development and learning - a child's journey of development is recorded by systematic observation and collection of children's works.

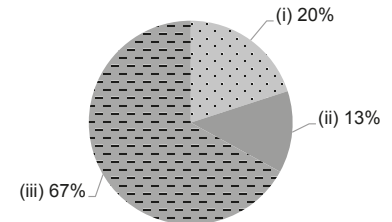
