Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>Our curricula feature theme-based teaching and project-based learning, and focus on children's life experience and physical quality. We provide a variety of Chinese and English reading and play activities, so that children can learn Chinese and English in a meaningful language context. Apart from teaching activities, we also arrange visits, expert interviews, field trips, parent-child activities, etc. We emphasize on children's development in creative arts. In addition, we also hold children's creative art exhibitions, creative drama performances and inter-school children's chorus every year.</p>
